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### **Questions for Discussion**

- 1. Why is it important that the Church be different from all the other entities of our world?
- 2. On a scale of 1 to 10, 1 being difficult and 10 being easy, where do you find yourself in terms of putting others first?
- 3. Talk about someone in your life who is good at welcoming others.
- 4. How does prejudice, favoritism, or discrimination affect our ability to accept others?
- 5. What have you discovered to be successful ways to live out the instruction to "bear with one another"?
- 6. Dr. Gene Getz writes that bearing with one another means "patiently enduring their idiosyncrasies and weaknesses." Idiosyncrasies are behaviors or ways of thinking peculiar to an individual. What are some of your idiosyncrasies? (Have fun with this one!)
- 7. In terms of being devoted to one another, talk about a time when you saw the Church come together to help a fellow believer in need.
- 8. If putting others first does not happen automatically in my life, what are some deliberate steps I can take to accept, bear with, and devote myself to other believers?

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
